**The Large Shelter is a fantastic multi-purpose shelter, it can be used as an outdoor classroom, a break time meeting place, an area for guided or non-guided outdoor role play or simply a space to sit and chat with friends in all but the very worst weather.**

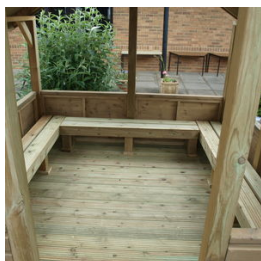
Capitalising on the many benefits of providing a safe and sheltered outdoor space for children the large shelter is available in different sizes to suit different playgrounds and budgets.

The Large Shelter has a high roof and low panel walls so there's plenty of visibility into and out of this shelter and the decked floor means children are never traipsing mud back into the classroom.

Available in four different sizes and with or without seating, the large shelter provides extra ground space and head room to provide maximum adaptability and versatility in larger playgrounds.

Seating is an optional extra and if required would be fitted along the rear and to each side of the Shelter.

The smallest of our large playground shelter seats around 14 children, with the others seating around 15, 16 and 20 respectively

### Guarantee

**Our Playground shelters are guaranteed against structural and design defect for 3 years - this does not cover acts of vandalism, misuse or exceptional natural events.**

#### Walls and general construction

- Polycarbonate glazing sheet is guaranteed unbreakable for the life of the product
- As long as the maintenance instructions are adhered to, the product will last substantially longer

#### Maintenance that is required

- Ensure that an air gap is maintained under the base and around all sides; check on an annual basis to ensure that there is not a build-up of debris
- The wood preservative paint will need re-coating every so often; (the same type of time scale as your house) this does depend on the prevailing weather conditions but would typically be 2 - 4 years.

### Specification

### Build Specification

The following specification reflects that of the featured build with the price shown at the top of this document. Please refer to our website for details on other build options.

#### Doors

##### Doorways

Open doorways are normally used on our castles or open structures, providing a great access route to all areas

- Made from good quality redwood, planed with swept edges
- Fits snugly within the wall of the structure to give a neat doorway/entrance
- Fully treated in your choice of colour from our standard range

## Floor

### Decking - Ground level

- The decking boards are good quality 38mm x 125mm grooved redwood boards that are pressure treated.
- The deck boards are screwed to the pressure treated timber bearers
- A weed prevention membrane is fitted below the decking to ensure that there is no plant growth up through the boards.

For an additional cost the decking can be painted with an anti slip paint, please ask for details.

## Roof

### Mineral Felt

A standard finish, good at keeping out the weather but not the most aesthetically pleasing of our roof options.

- The roof bearers are fitted to span across the apex: the size would depend on the span but it would be a minimum of 75mm x 50mm. The timber would be good quality redwood, planed with swept edges
- 12mm wbp external grade plywood is fitted to the top surface
- A layer of BBA approved breathable membrane is fitted as an underfelt
- A layer of 38kg mineral felt is fitted as the top surface and secured using galvanised staples.
- In the case of a large roof, pressure treated batons are fitted perpendicular to the roof felt
- The roof edges will be secured with a fascia board, the top finished with a ridge board and trim is fitted to the bottom.
- Guttering is always recommended and can either be fitted by us or retrospectively by you once installed.

## Other Options

This shelter can be customised to your preference by changing the build specification. The different build levels are explained in detail on our website.
